Your child should be dropped off and collected at the time specified for their class bubble.

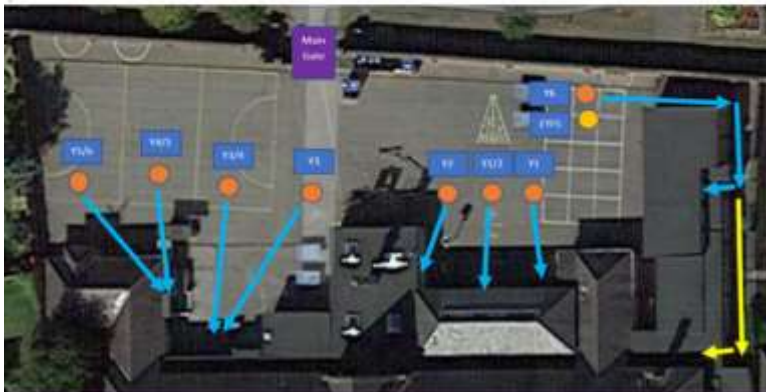
Collection Points

All year groups enter and exit through main gate. If possible, we ask that your child meets you outside the gates. Should you need to come onto the playground, please wait for your child in the same area that is marked on the image above. If you have more than one child, please wait in the area for your youngest child.

Social Distancing



Please ensure that there is no more than one adult dropping off and collecting your child to ensure that social distancing can be maintained. We know parking can be difficult so please allow time for this.



WHAT YOUR CHILD NEEDS



A FILLED WATER BOTTLE

Your child will need to bring their own water bottle each day - this must be filled with water only. They will take their bottle home each night ready for the next day.



PACKED LUNCH

If your child is not having a 'Grab a Bag' then you must provide them with a packed lunch. This will be stored in their storage container under their desks until lunch time.



COAT

Please ensure your child brings a suitable coat. Their coat will also be stored in their own storage container under their desks when they are in class.



BOOK BAG

Please avoid sending your child to school with a large backpack as they won't fit in the boxes. Your child should just bring their book bag. Eventually, all children will be given a home reading book which they must place into their home book bag.



PE KITS

On the day your child does PE, your child must come to school in their PE kit. They will stay in their PE kit throughout the day.

There is no PE in the first 3 days and you will be informed when your child's weekly PE day is going forward.

Allocated Seating

Your child will be allocated an eating and activity area based on their appropriate bubble and movement will be minimalised.



Drop Off

Breakfast club will **open at 8am** and the **last entry will be at 8.15am**.

Children coming to breakfast club will enter through the main gates and through the main entrance as they have done previously.

To ensure sufficient staffing and to enable us to maintain the safety measures we are putting in place, there will be no additional places available on the day.

IN THE CLASSROOM

Wellbeing



Regular wellbeing activities will be incorporated into the school day to ensure your child's wellbeing is key to their return to school. We have a specially designed curriculum for the return to school, prioritising well being as well as belonging to our school and local community.



Regular Handwashing

Within our bubbles, it will be impossible to maintain social distancing. Therefore, the focus will very much be on hand hygiene. Each classroom will have its own designated handwashing and sanitisation areas for regular handwashing.



Equipment

Your child will have their own resource box with all the equipment they need for their learning. Your child will need their bookbag in school. On the day they have PE they come dressed in their PE kit and PE shoes so they will have no need to change. We have no PE in the first three days and you will be informed when PE is for your child/children.



Bubbles

Your child's class is their 'Bubble'. At breakfast club, playtime and lunchtime, bigger bubbles can be created within phases but these will not mix. We will meet virtually as a whole school for Worship and Celebration Assemblies.



Cleaning

Regular cleaning will take place within the classroom between lessons throughout the day, alongside frequently touched surfaces. Any shared equipment will be sanitised before use by another 'Bubble'.

BREAK TIMES



Designated Play Areas

All classes have designated play times and play areas. Children will follow One-Way systems alongside designated Entrances and Exits to minimise mixing with other classes.



Class Play Equipment

Each bubble's equipment will be cleaned after each use and will only be shared once cleaned or 'quarantined' for 72 hours.



Handwashing Routines

Children will wash hands before and after break times.



Outdoor Play

Playtimes will be outside unless in extreme weather. Children should come to school with suitable coats for outdoor play and also use sun cream and sun hats when appropriate.



Toilet Breaks

Children will be encouraged to take toilet breaks at the beginning or end of their allocated break time to ensure they are not overly busy.

LUNCHTIMES



School Meals

First 5 days: Cold 'Grab Bags' only. KS1 and KS2 will eat in their classrooms. EYFS in hall. Following weeks: Hot and Cold 'Grab Bags'. Staggered times in hall.



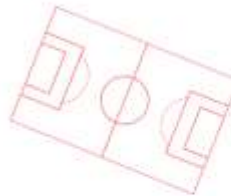
Packed Lunches

If your child would like to bring a packed lunch please ensure it is clearly named and in a suitable container.



Dining Area

From the first full week, each 'Bubble' will have a designated area and time in the hall to eat as a class each day. This will be cleaned thoroughly between classes.



Play Area

'Bubbles' will have a play time that is in their designated area and children will not be able to mix with children from other 'Bubbles'.



Hand Washing

Staff will support children to ensure handwashing routines are followed - before and after dinner - as children eat and move through the building.
